Background

- RSS in late 90s identified needs for CP in Jordan.
- Approached Swiss organizations.
- In June 2001, a MOU was signed between Jordan + Switzerland.
- RSS submitted a proposal to SECO in Oct. 2001.
- Assessment mission to finalize proposal in Feb 2003.
- Approval and selection of a Swiss Reference Center by SECO in Nov. 03 (FHBB-IfU, SBA & Carbotech)
- Preparation of the Business Plan and launching of the Project in March 2004.


